Program Notes

During the month of December, it can seem like we are surrounded by nothing but joy and triumph. Made for TV movies make it seem like these feelings are never more than 90 minutes and a small misunderstanding away. Even the Christmas story fast-forwards through the weeks of travel on donkey back, giving birth in a barn, and the mad-dash flight to Egypt, born out of fear for the life of a small child.

In the real world, moments of joy and triumph are tempered by the work of preparation and expectation, and often infused with stress, anxiety, loss, and confusion. This program celebrates the joy and triumph of Christmas while also acknowledging, exploring, and honoring the many complex emotions we have at this time of year.

In the last movement of his masterpiece *Dona Nobis Pacem*, composer Ralph Vaughan Williams juxtaposes the refrain of the angels ("good will toward men") with the final words of the Catholic Mass ("dona nobis pacem," grant us peace). This juxtaposition reminds us that peace, joy, and ultimately triumph do not come as gifts, but through the work of love, care, and good will toward each other.

About Tonight's Performers

Jason Vodicka, Music Director

Jason Vodicka is associate dean in the College of Arts and Sciences at Rider University, where he works with students in the School of Communication, Media, and Performing Arts, and Westminster Choir College. Known for his innovative work in choral pedagogy, Dr. Vodicka has conducted numerous honor choirs and presented at state, regional, national, and international conferences on music education. His writing can be found in publications such as Update: Applications of Research in Music Education. The Oxford Handbook of Choral Pedagogy, and Visions of Research in Music Education.

Matthew Smith, Organist

Matt has served as the Organist at Haddonfield UMC since attaining his Master of Music degree from Princeton, NJ's Westminster Choir College. He was awarded First Place at the 2017 Joan Lippincott Competition for Excellence in Organ Performance and continues to perform recitals on piano and organ at various venues. He is currently pursuing a Master of Music in Choral Conducting at Westminster Choir College, where he serves as a graduate assistant for Dr. James Jordan. Ben also serves as Music Director at Hopewell United Methodist Church, Hopewell, NJ.

New Jersey MasterChorale

The New Jersey MasterChorale is a 70-voice symphonic choir which was begun over 45 years ago as the Haddonfield UMC Oratorio Choir. An outreach of the HUMC music ministry, the NJMC has recently performed major works such as Haydn's *Lord Nelson Mass, Stravinsky's Symphony of Psalms*, and John Rutter's *Mass of the Children*. In addition to Philadelphia Orchestra and Friends, NJMC has recently partnered with other professional ensembles, such as Symphony in C, ChildrenSong of NJ, and the HUMC Holtz Handbell Choir.
