


MI WHA LEE MEMORIAL

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

"There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear; for fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not reached perfection in love." - 1 John 4:18

Over the summer, Pastor JiSun and I sent out a survey to help us plan sermon themes and Scriptures as we developed our preaching plans for this year. One of the questions in the survey asked what emotions people are wrestling with the most.

The results were very telling of the moment we are living in and the common challenges we face together. The top emotions that over 150 of our congregants said they struggle with the most are: anxiety, anger, regret, and fear.

Over and over in the Bible. Scripture points to a God that is not found through anger, regret, or fear but instead is found in joy, in grace, and in love. Jesus tells us not to worry and not to be afraid while 1 John 4 shows us that God's perfect love casts out all fear. And yet, here we are facing our very human emotions.

So what do we do about it when we are gripped with these less than romantic characteristics of being fully human? That is where faith comes in, why we need God, and why we need each other. We find deep love, joy, and grace through our loving God in Scripture and worship, and we seek to share those very attributes and remind one another of them through faith community.
