Living Ministry

For over 190 years, Haddonfield UMC has been a vibrant community of faith that makes a deep impact throughout our region. We continue to be a church that serves our wider community and is committed to making disciples of Jesus Christ for generations to come. In order to meet the opportunities and challenges ahead, we have established the Living Ministry endowment fund, which will help us maintain the staffing and programming that we need to fulfill our mission.Through the Vision of Hope Endowment funds, we seek to raise \$1.5 million to add to existing endowment funds as well as enhancements to our Fellowship Hall and Propert Café.

Financial Sustainability

Building financial sustainability through endowment will enable HUMC to meet rising overhead expenses and changing times without sacrificing the ministry and programming that is currently making a deep impact in our community. Established in 2016 through the estate of Daniel Cheney and added to through other generous gifts, The Living Ministry Fund currently has \$786,696 and 5% is used annually to help support our staff and ministry expenses. It is our intent to add \$1.25 million to the Living Ministry Fund to empower transformational ministry through this campaign.

Improving our Technology and Hospitality

Fellowship Hall is the home to our Modern and Online-Only worship services, as well as concerts and other events. This past year the number of those worshiping with us through our online and streaming services has exceeded the number of people worshiping in-person. The audio/ visual system in Fellowship Hall is 15 years old, and many components have come to the end of their life cycle. The current lighting and cameras need to be updated for better live-streaming and worship production. Updating and properly equipping that room for live-streaming and worship production will help improve the quality of worship and concert experiences, and meet people where they are for the sake of the Gospel.

In the pandemic, Propert Hall became the primary gathering and foodservice space in the church, earning it the name Propert Café. We need to upgrade the carpet, food service/coffee bar, and lighting to make this a safe space for hospitality and gathering for meals together. It is our intent to raise \$250,000 for enhancements to the audio/visual system and Propert Café.
